



SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

ANY VIOLATION OF THESE REGULATIONS MAY RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EXPULSION FROM THE POOL AND/OR CAMPSITE.

OBLIGATIONS

- The Las Dunas identification bracelet has to worn visibly to have access to the swimming pool
- It is obligated to take a shower each time before you enter the water (so the water is no polluted with salt, sweat, sand etc.)
- The instructions of the lifeguards always have to be obeyed.
- The safety regulations have to be respected and obeyed.
- Respect other users
- Children who can't swim have to use flotation devises that keep their head above water.
- The exit area of the water slides has to be cleared immediatly.
- The use of appropriate swimming clothes for swimming pools is obligated
- Waste has to be disposed of in the rubbish bins

PROHIBITIONS

- Access is prohibited to children under 12 years of age without the company of an adult.
- Children who can't swim are not allowed to use the waterslides and therefore any floating device is prohibited on the waterslides.
- Eating and drinking is not allowed in and around the swimming pool (except plastic water bottles)
- Smoking is not allowed in and around the swimming pool
- Glass and other breakable objects are not allowed in and around the swimming pool (glasses, cups, sunglasses etc.)
- Access is prohibited for animals (except guide dogs)
- The use of scuba diving goggles and fins, as well as (inflatable) balls, toys and airbeds is prohibited
- It is not allowed to jump or dive into the water.
- It is not allowed to push other people under water, or climb on top of each other
- It is not allowed to spill fluids and other products into the water.
- Access is prohibited to people with contagious skin diseases (in case of doubt the staff is entitled to ask for a medical certificate)
- Deckchairs may not be used to store objects or for any other purpose than sun bathing.

RECOMENDATIONS

- Enjoy the sun with moderation, always use a sun screen, adequate for your type of skin and take a shower each time before you enter the water.
- Children always have to be under surveillance of an adult and may not be lost out of sight.
- Don't let small children play too close to the large basin which is not suitable to them.
- Don't get in the water too soon after eating, sun bathing or physical exercise (take a shower before accessing the water)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The first aid kit is located left of the swimming pool entrance.
- Colour and texture of clothing may be affected by the used cleaning products.
- Camping las Dunas may not be held responsible for lost objects (found objects are deposited in the laundry service).

NORMS OF USE

- The identification bracelet grants access to the swimming pool.
- Every pool user has to identify him- or herself if requested by our staff.
- The swimming pool reserves the right to grant or deny access. Every user agrees with the internal rules and regulations of the campsite and the swimming pool.
- Staff is authorised to remove people from the swimming pool premises and the campsite if rules are infringed or instructions from the lifeguards are not followed. Also for any behaviour that causes damage to other people or objects
